COPPA Direct Notice to Parents

As part of your child's Family Banking account, Technology Credit Union ("TCU") may collect personal information from your child online. This information may be collected by TCU or by a third party to: provide users with access to features and activities on our website and mobile application; customize content and improve our website and mobile application; conduct research and analysis to address the performance of our website and mobile application; and generate anonymous reporting for use by TCU. Parental consent is required for the collection, use, or disclosure of such information from children under the age of 13. TCU will not collect, use, or disclose any personal information from your child unless you provide your consent.

TCU may collect the following personal information from your child once your child is able to access the website:

- A home or other physical address including street name and name of a city or town;
- Online contact information:
- A screen or user name that functions as online contact information:
- A telephone number;
- Geolocation data;
- Persistent identifiers;

If you consent to our collection of information from your child, TCU may also share or disclose such information in the following instances:

- We may share information with our service providers if necessary for them to perform a business, professional, or technology support function for us.
- We may disclose personal information if permitted or required by law.

At any time, you may refuse to permit TCU to collect further personal information from your child online, and can request that TCU delete the personal information TCU has collected in connection with that account. Please keep in mind that a request to delete records may lead to your child being unable to access the TCU Family Banking platform online. If we change the way we collect, use or disclose your child's personal information, we will send you a new notice and request for another consent.

We use two methods to allow parents to access, change, or delete the personal information that we have collected from their children:

- 1. Parents can request access to and delete their child's personal information by logging on to the child's account. Parents will need their child's username and password.
- 2. Parents can contact TCU directly at 800-553-0880.

In any correspondence to TCU such as e-mail or mail, please include the child's username and the parent's email address and telephone number. To protect children's privacy and security, we will take reasonable steps to help verify a parent's identity before granting access to any personal information.
